- have a basic knowledge of career opportunities in the labor market and of the job search process.

Vocational competences:

- operate and perform routine maintenance of agricultural mechanization and maintain workshop equipment;
- manage the work with hand tools, machines and equipment and normal working operations needed to manufacture the
 product or to implement appropriate corrections;

- use the normal operation of manual processing of metals;
- use basic technology operations of machining, especially turning, milling, shaping and grinding;
- measure with standard gauges with sufficient precision;
- determine the causes of common disorders, conduct routine repairs and check the proper adjustment of the machine repaired:
- ready to pass welding test before the commissioner in the range of courses ZK 111 W01 or ZK 135 W01;
- drive motor vehicles class T.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The graduate is employed in the field of agricultural repair and service in the position of agricultural worker focused on the performance of repair work. He/she mainly performs their own repairs, maintenance and adjustment of machines and equipment, but also possibly involved in the production and restoration of parts.

Examples of possible jobs: agricultural worker with a focus on the performance of repair work.

The graduate is employed in the farms, in service businesses for agriculture, or in his own business.
